2019 'Bright Tank' Information and Consent Form

Dear Parent/Caregiver,

At Brighton Secondary School in Week 8 of this term we are inviting year 10 students to participate in the 'Bright Tank' Enterprise Innovation Program from Monday 2 to Friday 6 December. All students who successfully participate will receive 10 x Stage 1 SACE credits (the equivalent of a full semester year 11 subject). The details of the program were explained to all year 10 students at an assembly on Friday 25 October.

For those students that wish to participate there will be a \$70.00 administration fee which is payable to the Student Reception before the end of week 5 (15 November 2019). There is a limit of 100 places available in the program so the participants will be decided according to the order that payment is received.

The 'Bright Tank' program objective is to engage high school students to focus on solving real world problems for local businesses, start-ups and organisations. Over the week, students help local businesses and organisations to leap forward by addressing their problems, developing new or improving products and services and building digital and marketing capability. The week's activities culminate with a *pitch* competition where students sell their innovative idea to industry experts including entrepreneurs and business people. They will demonstrate the solution they have come up with including prototypes or new products, services and solutions that have been created.

On Monday 2 December at 8.40am students will report to the year 11 study area where they will sign in and receive their name-tag (which we expect to be worn for the whole week), and the program (which you need to bring each day). Students are encouraged to wear neat casual attire (e.g. shirt, pants, skirt) OR full school uniform for the week.
