Dear Parent/Caregiver,

'Bright Tank' Enterprise Innovation Program (a revamped Australian Business Week) is our first student option. This is a fantastic week and a great opportunity for students to showcase their leadership, problem solving, team work and communication skills, through developing and marketing a solution to a real problem in a real business in the local area. A letter regarding 'Bright Tank' was distributed to students this week and registration to participate is by Friday 15 November 2019 (week 5).

Students not participating in 'Bright Tank' can choose to do a week of Work Experience. The relevant work placement form can be collected from the student's Home Group teacher or on the wall near Ms Reid's office.

A further option in Week 8 is for students to work in their part-time paid employment. This must be paid daytime work covering the school day (min of 25 hours). Parent confirmation of the paid work option will be required either through written correspondence or phone contact with the Home Group teacher, outlining workplace details and nominal hours to be worked.

We expect ALL year 10 students will be actively involved in one of the options outlined above.
