Dear Parents/Caregivers

As you know, this year has created a range of challenges for us all, including the difficulty of arranging large gatherings of people. As a school we had planned to run a Parent Information Evening on Thursday 19 November, hoping that COVID-19 restrictions would allow us to proceed. However, this is not the case and, unfortunately we now need to cancel this event.

We are currently investigating alternative ways to share the information with you that we had planned for the evening, and we will communicate with you about this soon.

We hope your child has enjoyed their transition events to date, which have included visits to their school by Brighton Secondary School staff and current Year 8 students, and recent visits by primary school groups for a tour and 'get to know you' session.
