# To Support Effective Teaching and Learning

To best support our Brighton Secondary School community, in maintaining clean, safe and functional spaces that align with Workplace Health and Safety policies and procedures:

## We will maintain clean learning environments through:

- keeping windows clear of posters and notices
- displaying posters only using blu tack on walls or pins on pinboards
- keeping cupboards and shelving tidy with current resources
- keeping shared spaces clear of clutter

### We will encourage students to take pride in the school and their space through:

- asking them to pick up rubbish and tidy the room before they leave
- keeping work displayed on walls current and relevant
- only displaying current notices, logos, and procedures
- encouraging students to pick up and place their rubbish in the bin during break periods

### We will maintain resources and equipment by:

- ensuring students are not sitting or leaning on tables with wheels to avoid damage
- reporting any safety or maintenance issues to ensure they can be remedied as quickly as possible
