

Clean, Safe and Functional Spaces

To Support Effective Teaching and Learning

To best support our Brighton Secondary School community, in maintaining clean, safe and functional spaces that align with Workplace Health and Safety policies and procedures:

We will maintain clean learning environments through:

- keeping windows clear of posters and notices
- displaying posters only using blu tack on walls or pins on pinboards
- keeping cupboards and shelving tidy with current resources
- keeping shared spaces clear of clutter

We will encourage students to take pride in the school and their space through:

- asking them to pick up rubbish and tidy the room before they leave
- keeping work displayed on walls current and relevant
- only displaying current notices, logos, and procedures
- encouraging students to pick up and place their rubbish in the bin during break periods

We will maintain resources and equipment by:

- ensuring students are not sitting or leaning on tables with wheels to avoid damage
- reporting any safety or maintenance issues to ensure they can be remedied as quickly as possible
