Stage 1 Exam Expectations

Semester 1, 2024



It is essential that students are familiar with the following exam expectations:

Attendance

It is important that your student arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled start time for the exam. Please check the Examination timetable carefully.

If your young person is unwell on the day of the exam, they will need to provide a medical certificate within 24 hours of their exam time to Lani Trimboli.

Equipment

Both scribbling paper (SACE only) and writing paper will be supplied. Students are responsible for the provision of writing implements and calculators, including graphics calculators. The mathematics faculty will give students the chance to register for a school-issued calculator.

If using their own calculator, students are advised to check their implement is working and have spare new batteries.

No phones, smart watches, or electronic devices are allowed, and students are reminded to leave these belongings in their lockers.

All stationery must be in a clear plastic refill pocket.

Water bottles are allowed but must be clear, with no labels.

Students can have access to a dictionary.

Electronic examinations

Some subject exams are electronic, and will require students to bring their own device fully charged and ready for the examination. Subject teachers will communicate these requirements prior to the exams.

VET students

Students undertaking a VET course on the same day as a scheduled exam are required to attend their VET.
