What is Core Music?

In Core Music you will have the opportunity to play in a class band, string ensemble or percussion ensemble. If you do not already play an instrument, that's ok. We welcome beginners to Core Music. If you already play an instrument, that's great too.

Instrumental Tuition

You will have access to free instrumental music lessons every week to support your learning. Instruments are available for hire (at a fee) from the school so there is no need to own or purchase an instrument.

Choosing Core Music will also allow you to participate in the many co-curricular ensembles and choirs available before school, at lunchtime and after school.

Opportunities and Pathways

Core Music students are also eligible for the incredible local and international music tours.

Studying Core Music in Year 7 enables a pathway to future years of studying music in the middle years at Brighton Secondary School all the way through to Stage 1 and 2 SACE Music subjects.
